Your application will be processed according to the information provided on this form. You must notify the Office of Financial Aid immediately of any changes in your enrollment plans. Any financial aid you receive is subject to adjustment, cancellation and/or repayment if you fail to enroll as stated on this application. Students will be notified via their PRCC email accounts should summer Pell grant become unavailable due to congressional changes in Title IV funding.

- **Students must meet admission requirements before financial aid can be awarded.**
- **Students seeking a second scheduled Pell Grant award must enroll and complete a minimum of six (6) credit hours during the summer 2011 semester.**
- **Students who have received 100% of a first scheduled Pell Grant award must meet the requirement for completing 24 hours and must complete a minimum of six (6) hours during the summer semester to be eligible for a second scheduled Pell Grant award.**
- **Students must meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) to be eligible for summer aid. Even though a student may be awarded financial aid for summer, the student may become ineligible if SAP is not met at the end of the spring 2011 semester.**

Certification: If it is determined that I am not eligible for financial aid, I understand that I am completely responsible for my educational expenses at Pearl River Community College.
I also understand that if I drop or withdraw from courses; my Pell award for the summer semester may be cancelled or reduced and I will ultimately be responsible for my summer tuition and all other expenses incurred as a result of my attendance at PRCC during the summer semester.
