

STUDENT CONDUCT

Policy:

Pearl River Community College expects appropriate conduct of students at all times.

Procedure:

The student whose actions are disrupting normal classroom activities will be asked by the instructor to refrain from disrupting classroom activities. If this disruptive action continues, the student will be referred to the Dean of Student Services, if on the Poplarville Campus, to the Dean of the Forrest County Center, or to the Director of the Hancock Center. The student's due process proceeding will be initiated.
