## **SOFTWARE DESCRIPTIONS AND LESSONS QUESTION DESIGNER**

**(Question Mark Computing) \*Windows Version \*Networked**

**Description:** QUESTION MARK is a computer program that allows the instructor to deliver tests, exams, tutorials, and other kinds of assessment. Using the software, you enter questions on any topic into the computer; students respond to the questions on-screen, and the computer marks and analyzes the answers. QUESTION MARK is suitable for use both by individual trainers and teachers, seeking to create test for their students. There are several different ways in which users can answer a question on QUESTION MARK DESIGNER:

1. Multiple Choice
2. Multiple Response
3. Graphical Hotspot
4. Numeric Question Answer
5. Text Questions
