

ACCREDITATION

In 2009 the College's Physical Therapist Assistant Technology Program accreditation was reaffirmed by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education.

In 2009 the College's Occupational Therapy Assistant Technology Program accreditation was reaffirmed by the American Council for Occupational Therapy Education. A plan of correction for areas of non-compliance is to be submitted in October 2009.

In 2008 the College's Surgical Technology Program accreditation was reaffirmed by the Accreditation Review Committee on Education in Surgical Technology. There were no recommendations.

In 2008 the College's Dental Hygiene Technology and Dental Assisting Technology Programs accreditations were reaffirmed by the American Dental Association. There were no recommendations.

In 2008 the College's Early Childhood Education Technology Program accreditation was reaffirmed by the National Academy of Early Childhood Programs. There were no recommendations.

In 2007 the College's Medical Radiologic Technology Program accreditation was reaffirmed by The Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology. There were no recommendations.

In 2006 the accreditation of Pearl River Community College was reaffirmed by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools to award associate degrees. There were no recommendations.

In 2006 the College's Respiratory Care Technology Program accreditation was reaffirmed until June 2013 by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs. There were no recommendations.

In 2005 the College's Medical Laboratory Technology Program accreditation was reaffirmed by the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Sciences. There were no recommendations.

In 2004 the College's Practical Nursing Program accreditation was reaffirmed by the Mississippi State Department of Education. There were no recommendations.

In 2003 the College's Associate Degree Nursing Program accreditation was reaffirmed by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc., 3343 Peachtree Road NE, Suite 500, Atlanta, Georgia 30326. There were no recommendations. This program is also accredited annually by the Mississippi Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning. This accreditation is based upon a certification report prepared by the College.

In 2003 the College's Automotive Mechanics Technology Program received the Automotive Service Excellence Certification. There were no recommendations.
