



# Out-of-District CTE Scholarship Application

Students who reside outside of PRCC’s district are eligible for CTE scholarships if they meet the following criteria:

- Successfully completed two years of a career-technical program at their high school (letter from counselor required)
- Enroll at PRCC full-time (at least 15 credit hours), within one year of graduating from high school
- Overall high school GPA of 3.5 (for full tuition scholarship) or 3.0 (for half tuition scholarship)
- Complete PRCC’s admissions process and send final high school and/or college transcripts after graduating high school

Please send the following documents to the address listed below ***AFTER you graduate from high school!***

- 1) This completed application
- 2) A final high school transcript that lists your graduation date and cumulative GPA
- 3) A letter from your high school counselor certifying that you have completed a two-year CTE program. The letter must be signed and on school letterhead.
