
Career-Technical Scholarship

For graduates of schools having an Articulated Training Agreement with Pearl River Community College, full tuition and half tuition scholarships will be awarded to entering career-technical freshmen who meet the following qualifications:

- High school diploma
- Completed a two-year career-technical program in high school
- Enroll full time (within a year after high school graduation) in a career-technical program at PRCC
- Full tuition scholarships require overall "B" average or above in high school
- Half tuition scholarships require overall "C" average in academic courses with an "A" average in career-technical program courses in high school

Requirements for Admission

- Be eighteen (18) years of age or older by program completion
- Admissions application to Pearl River Community College (also available online at www.prcc.edu)
- Cosmetology Program Application Packet
- Two official transcripts (high school or GED)
- Official college/university transcript (if applicable)
- Score of 9.0 in Mathematics and 10.0 in Reading on the Test of Adult Education (TABE)
- Acceptable result on drug screen and tuberculosis skin test

Why College?

Research shows that education pays. Students who complete associate degrees and certificates are more likely to move into professional positions with higher earnings. Students with a solid education beyond high school can expect to earn an average of \$250,000 more than people with only a high school diploma.

About the Program

The Cosmetology Program is a one-year (three semester) program of study designed to lead to a Certificate of Proficiency.

The instructional program provides a curriculum which includes the theory, skills, and salon ethics required to become a licensed cosmetologist. Students practice techniques in a supervised salon setting including hairstyling, nail care, chemical services, and skin care. Instruction includes emphasis on hygiene, sanitation, customer relations, and salon management. The curriculum is designed to comply with the standards of the Mississippi State Board of Cosmetology with the requirement of 1500 contact hours of instruction for students.

Upon satisfactory completion of the program of study a student will eligible to request examination by the Mississippi State Board of Cosmetology to become a licensed cosmetologist in the state of Mississippi.

Enrollment is open in the fall semester. Selection for admission into the Cosmetology Program is based on the date of cosmetology application, TABE score and slot availability.

Career Outlook

According to the Department of Labor, overall employment of cosmetologists is projected to grow through 2014. The employment opportunity in the field of Cosmetology is excellent. Cosmetology is a growing and ever-changing field and offers great opportunity to people acquiring licensure. Professionals may choose one of several careers including Licensed Cosmetologist, Nail Technician, Salon Manager/Owner, and instructor.
